## **Working for us**

Q. What are the usual working hours?

A. Stewardship's expected hours will be based on the role and skillset that you bring to the organization. Stewards will be provided housing on the property in exchange for work they provide to maintain the off-grid homestead.

Q. What staff benefits do you offer?

A. Once your probation period has passed there are number of benefits available to staff:

- Subsidized housing to live off the land
- Assistance with VA or State benefit paperwork
- Assistance with making and/or attending physical and psychiatric appointments

The organization is seeking self sufficient individuals that bring their experience to support an off-grid village, sustained completely off the land provided. Our goal is to provide support for homeless veterans that need patience, love, and support.

Everyone will be expected to support the community and learn or foster valuable skillsets while in the community as well as to take with them when they move forward.
